#### No clear distinction between theft and fraud

stolen cars used to rebuild wrecked car
falsifying vehicle documents, shipping documents, import documents
cars sold and reported stolen
tampering with identity of cars
involvement of staff in cargo theft
tampering with age / mileage / ....

The bad guys do it all!!

responsibilities
knowledge
information
power to solve the problem

# What insurers (can) do

- VbV, a specialized bureau for vehicle crime of the Dutch insurers
  - early warning signal lost vehicles
  - ICRV point
  - managing of certification systems
  - exchange data with authorities about wrecked vehicles
  - theft signals of non-registered items: boats, heavy equipment
  - influence owners to make a "passport" for their boat / machine / bicycle /.....
  - influence authorities to do what is necessary and more to have the best registration system
  - influence authorities to register boats / bicycles / etc.

## Early warning signal

"missing" vehicles
7x7 / 24 hrs
by telephone
temporary signal in vehicle register
overruled by formal police theft signal

- Police
- Insurance companies

#### ICRV point

In the Netherlands: checking data in both public and private databases

vehicle register
mileage register
car history register
insurers' information
police data (limited)

-car branch
-car branch
-insurers
-police

#### Managing of certification systems

quality of alarm systems and tracking & tracing systems

insurers
automotive sector
police
private alarm centers

#### Exchange data wrecked vehicles

insurers inform vehicle register RDW
 RDW puts signal: "waiting for inspection"
 after repairs: inspection by RDW, repairs plus identity

- insurance companies
- expertise companies
- repairs branch
- RDW
- police

### "Passports"

most owners do not know the right details of their property
 most insurers do not know what they insure
 source of misunderstanding and fraud

- consumer organization
- boating / cycling clubs
- boat /bicycle /equipment manufacturers
- insurance companies
- police

# Do the necessary and more to get the best vehicle registration

how to make sure someone takes care of

- identity check imported used vehicles
- check authenticity of documents
- check completeness of documents
- check vehicle details via EUCARIS
- check SIS, ASF
- exchange info with country of origin
- take action in case of clones / irregularities
- etc
  - what do insurers do
  - what does the police do
  - what does the registration authority do
  - how to involve the importers / car branch

I. Monitoring, statistics and analysis
II. Prevention
III. Repression

# Project Monitoring, statistics and analysis

Coordinator : AVc Other involved organizations: all 13

- harmonized definitions of transport criminality.
- improvement of quality of crime reports
- umbrella organizations encourage members to provide more / all crime reports

### Project Companies- and Company Grounds

Coordinator: "shippers association" EVO Other involved organizations: 6 out of 13

- information and advice to transport companies
- cooperation with local authorities: safe parking places

## Safe Parking

Coordinator : Ministry of Transport Other involved organizations: 7 out of 13

- development national policy safe parking places
- evaluation improvement 20 least secure P places
- development safe parking places, certification EU standard (Label)
- encouragement use of safe P places

### Chain approach

Coordinators: TAPA en AVc Other involved organizations: 8 out of 13

Actions:

 development supply chain model with preventive measures

#### Internal criminality

Coordinator : transport branch Other involved companies: 7 out of 13

- standard model recruitment personnel
- awakening sector to internal criminality
- encouragement to report internal crime

### Prevention

Coordinators: 3 branch associations Other involved organizations: 9 out of 13

- promote responsibility crime prevention on highest level (board of directors of companies)
- development fast alarm messages from police to transport sector
- crime prevention in training professional drivers
- promote alarm button in trucks

#### Repression

Coordinator : Police Other involved organizations: 10 out of 13 Ministry of Justice and TAPA

- police create account managers transport crime
- intensifying police capacity

### International

Coordinators: AVc and Ministry of Economic Affairs Other involved organizations: all 13

- creation desk to report crime in foreign country
- periodical discussions at EU level
- joint international police actions
- TAPA to organize seminars regularly (4 x per year)

Lots of ambitions for the next three years
